

RULES **** Polygraphs will be administered**** ****No Kayaks ****

**** HOURLY UPDATES WILL BE GIVEN BY KNCT 91.3 FM ****

- 1. *Rules:* The decision of the Tournament Director is final in all matters. All protests must be received within 15 minutes of the scales closing. Scales close at 3:30 PM.
- 2. *Registration times* morning of 0500 AM-0600 AM. *Registration opens* 1 January 2025! Boat numbers assigned upon receipt of payment and registration. All teams are required to meet at Cedar Ridge Park, Turkey Roost for registration and Tournament briefing.
- 3. *Entry Fee:* \$200 per boat, check or money order, Venmo, CashApp, (\$210 thru PayPal) until 1 September 2025 starting 2 September 2025 <u>CASH ONLY</u>.
- 4. *Participation/Eligibility:* Anyone under 18 years of age must have the signature of their parent or legal guardian.
- 5. *Pre-Tournament Practice:* Belton Lake will NOT be off limits the week preceding the tournament date.
- 6. *Trailering:* Will be allowed. Everyone *must* check-in at Cedar Ridge Park, Turkey Roost before the start of the tournament.
- 7. *Official measuring stick is the Check-It-Stick*! Courtesy check available prior to presenting to weigh master.
- 8. *Weigh In for 5 fish limit:* This is a 5 fish limit per team. Only Largemouth, Smallmouth, or Spotted Bass 14 inches or greater will be weighed in. Any team bringing to the scales a bass under the 14 inch limit will be charged 1 pound penalty and any team bringing in a dead fish will be charged ¹/₂ pound penalty. No under size fish will be weighed. Official measuring stick is the Check-It-Stick.
- 9. If a sickly fish is brought to scale early angler must declare if it's a **BIG** fish for hourly or a fish for 5 bag limit. **ALSO** at no time will there be more than 5 fish in the live well.
- 10. Weigh In for Hourly Big Bass: Fish MUST be weighed within the hour timeframe (7 AM-8 AM at 8:01AM that will be considered the 8 AM to 9 AM hour). Only Largemouth, Smallmouth, or Spotted Bass 14 inches or greater will be weighed in. No dead fish will be weighed for hourly Big Bass. No under size fish will be weighed. Official measuring stick is the Check-It-Stick. ***Fish presented for hourly big bass will not count towards your five fish limit bag.***
- 11. *Payout for 5 fish limit:* 1st place team will be awarded \$3,000.00, 2nd place will be awarded \$2,000.00 3rd place team will be awarded \$1,000. *MUST BE PRESENT TO COLLECT PRIZES!*

- 12. *Payout for Hourly Big Bass:* \$1,000 will be awarded hourly for the heaviest Bass weighed in for the hour, based on 50 boats. If no fish weigh in for the hour the monies will be donated to Pink Fishing. *MUST BE PRESENT TO COLLECT PRIZES!*
- 13. *Late penalty:* Any team not at the official weigh-in site (Bump Tanks, standing in line) by the appointed time (3:30 PM) will be assessed a .5 pound penalty per minute late. Exceptions will have to be cleared through the Tournament Director. 5 fish limit weigh in only.
- 14. Start/Stop Times: During the "Reeling in the Cure" Tournament, lines in at 6:00 AM. and lines out at 3:00 PM, (You must be in the weigh-in line by 3:30 PM) Last Hourly Big Bass will be weighed at 2 PM. Five fish limit bags will be weighed at 3 PM. Scales will close at 3:30 PM. Tournament times are subject to change due to lake conditions or the weather.
- 15. *Safe Boating:* Safe boating will be observed at all times. Each team member must wear a fastened, U.S. Coast Guard approved, personal flotation device when the gas motor is running. All boats must be equipped with some type of emergency ignition cut-off device (kill switch) on any remote steered outboard while main engine is in use. Ignition cut-off device (kill switch) must be attached to boat operator at all times while main engine is in use. Kill switch must operate properly. When the kill switch is activated; the outboard main engine must stop running immediately. However, kill switches are not required with hand operated engines unless equipped with one when manufactured.
- 16. *Permitted Fishing Methods:* All Bass must be caught alive in a conventional sporting manner from a boat. Only artificial lures may be used with the exception of pork trailers. Only one fishing rod at a time may be used. Trolling with the combustion engine as a method of fishing is prohibited. Your team may weigh in only fish caught by your team.
- 17. *Sportsmanship/Conduct:* All contestants are required to follow high standards of sportsmanship, courtesy, conservation, and all Lake and state of Texas Regulations.
- 18. *Alcohol/Non-Prescription Drugs:* The use of alcohol and/or any non-prescription drugs during any of the tournament hours or at the weigh-in site will result in total team disqualification and no fish will be weighed for that team on that day. From 5:00 AM to 6:00 PM.
- 19. *Permitted fishing location:* Contestants may fish anywhere on tournament waters, except areas designed "NO FISHING", "NO BOATS", "KEEP OUT" or within 50 yards of another boat that is anchored with trolling motor out of water, or within 25 yards of another competitor's boat unless otherwise agreed upon by other tournament angler.
- 20. *Polygraph:* All prize winners are subject to a polygraph test. Polygraph testing will be performed at the discretion of the Tournament Director at any time. Anyone who is required to take a polygraph must pass the test before receiving any prizes. If a winner refuses to take a polygraph, he or she will be disqualified. Polygraph tests will be administered the day of the tournament. If you are in the money make yourself and team member available at all times.
- 21. *Ties:* All ties will be broken by the flip of a coin unless the teams agree to split the pot.
- 22. *Leaving the lake early:* Anyone leaving the lake early before the end of the tournament must contact the Tournament Director or any other member to let someone know that you are leaving early. This keeps us from searching in case of trouble while on the water.
